WHEREAS, the AUTHORS of the Trust have appointed themselves as the TRUSTEES of the TRUST

NOW THEREFORE THIS DEED OF TRUST DECLARES AND WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS :-

1) Name of the Trust :- The name of the TRUST shall be called "SRI VANI EDUCATION CENTRE TRUST".

2) Office of the Trust :- The Office of the Trust shall be for the present situated at No. 1246, 4th Main, 'E' Block, II Stage, Rajajinagar, Bangalore - 560 010. and / or such other place or places as the TRUSTEES may decide from time to time.

3) Names and addresses of the Trustees:- The names and addresses of the Trustees are as shown above.

4) Objects :- The objects of the TRUST are mainly as under :-

a) To promote education in India in all faculties like medicine, engineering, arts, and Commerce, Science, Law, Technology, Nursing, Pharmacy, Dental including Nursery, Primary, Middle and High Schools and also Pre-University Level.

b) To create, organise and run Colleges, Schools, Institutes and other Centres of learning and also opening of Hostels, Hospitals, Recreation Centres, Orphanages and Libraries.

c) To provide Physical Education, Sports, Music, Dance, Literary, and other extra curricular training for the children.

d) To provide Teachers Training College for the benefit of the Primary and Secondary School

- e) To establish a residential school for a systematic and well-disciplined training of the students.
- f) To construct, equip and maintain these institutions and to create the means of raising revenue for the TRUST.
- g) To strive for maintenance, growth and development of academic standards and to enter collaboration agreements, etc.
- h) To help the poor and organise charities for needy students & other educational institutions.
- i) To generate and promote opportunities for self-employment while establishing the appropriate educational institutions.
- j) To apply the funds of the TRUST for advancement of knowledge, education and service for the benefit of members of general public within India, without any discrimination of caste, colour, sect, creed or sex.
- k) To acquire any educational institutions those which are unable to manage and run or such institutions which desire to be merged with this TRUST, for achievement of the above objects.
- l) Generally on such object of charity and public good as the Trustees may think proper and those which are covered by the definition of 'Charitable Purpose' as per the provisions of Section 2(15) of the Income-tax Act, 1961, with all the statutory modifications and amendments thereof in future.

5. Funds of the Trust :- The funds of the TRUST shall constitute the amount settled by the AUTHORS OF THE TRUST as shown in schedule hereunder and in addition all the moneys that may be received from the public in the form of donations, membership fee, subscriptions grants from Charitable Institutions, Municipalities, Corporations, State Government and Central Government and/or Local Bodies, Statutory or Non-statutory corporations, etc.

6. Movable & Immovable :- The Trust apart from acquiring movable properties is also empowered to acquire Immovable Properties as may be decided by Trustees from time to time.

7. Accounting Year :- The accounting year of the Trust shall be from 1st day of April to 31st day of March every year.

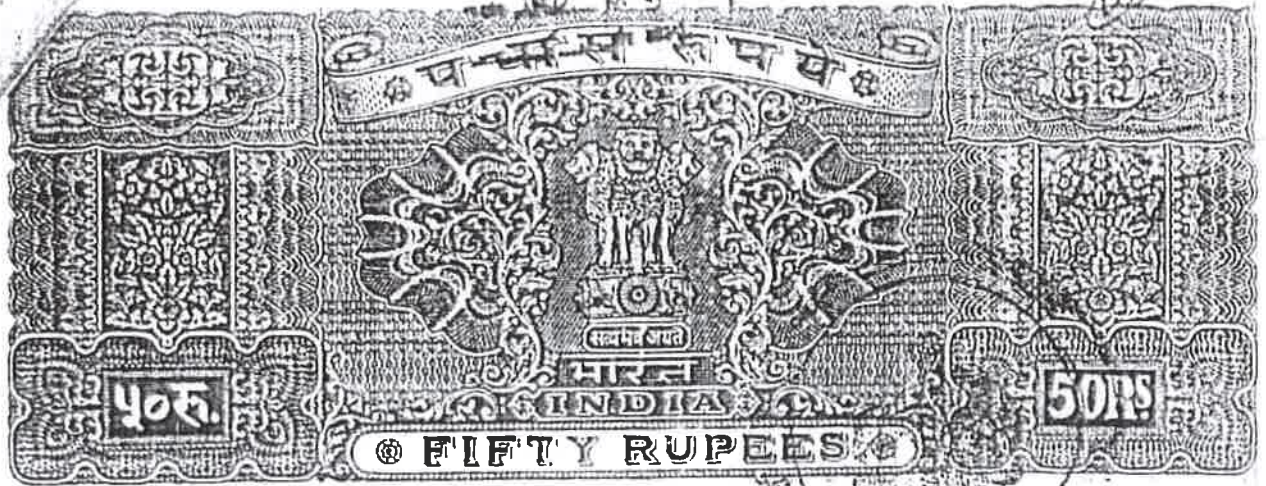

8. **Managing Committee :** All the Trustees constitute themselves as Managing Committee for managing the affairs of the Trust. The Managing Committee is empowered to :

a) Make all appointments of staff both teaching and non-teaching for its various institutins.

b) Remove, suspend or dismiss the staff in case of warranting circumstances.

c) Purchase of land and building, construct and also to sell, lease or mortgage the properties of the TRUST.

d) Obtain whenever necessary over draft facilities from any bank or banks and from financial Institutions for managing the affairs of the Trust.

e) Invest funds of the TRUST in Debentures, National Savings Certificates, Fixed Deposits in any legally established institutions and in any form of securities as may be decided by the Trustees from time to time in the interest of the TRUST.

f) The members of the Board of Trustees shall have power to co-opt one or more persons as members of the Board of Trustees for such period as they may deem fit and fill up any vacancy in the Board within the aforementioned limits as they may deem fit from time to time subject to a maximum of nine members. Any person appointed as member by the board of trustees shall hold such office only for such period for which he is appointed or till he voluntarily resigns.

g) The Board of Trustees may appoint one or more among them to do such activities as may be assigned with such designation as may be found suitable and shall have power to fix the duties, responsibilities, powers, period of office etc., of the persons so appointed, However, the Board shall have power to remove any person from any office by a resolution passed and accepted by a majority of members of Board as constituted as the time.

h) The Board may manage the affairs of the Trust by appointing committees as they may deem fit or in any other way as they deem fit from time to time. The Board shall have powers to frame & adopt the rules and regulations, terms of reference and conditions of committes or such other bodies formed for the management of the affairs of the trust and shall also have powers to vary the constitution of management of such committees.

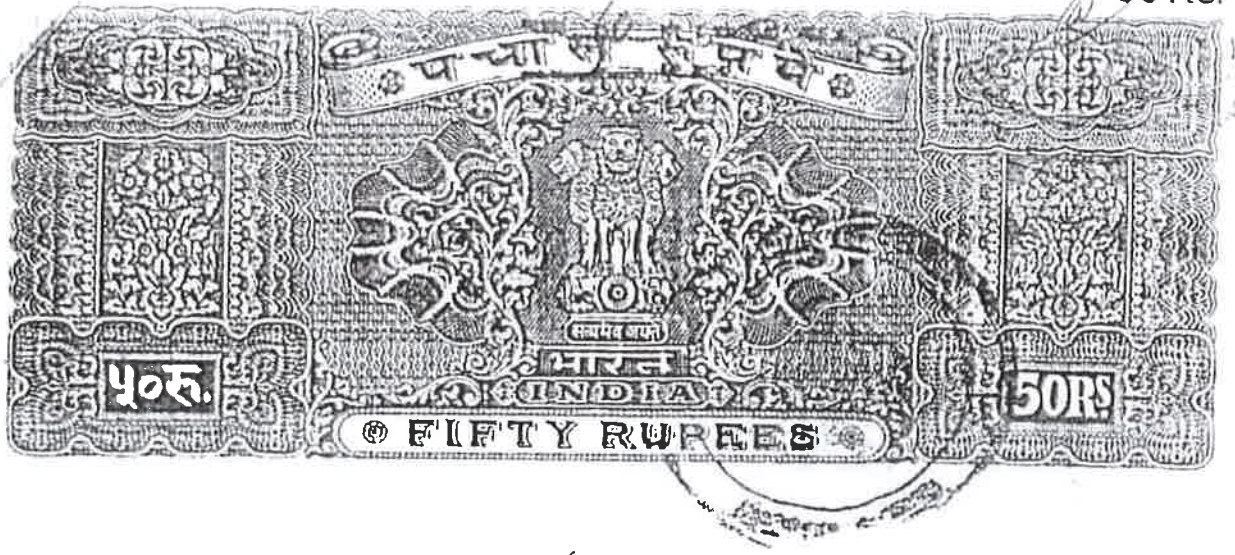

- i) In case of tie, the managing trustee shall have an additional vote called casting vote.
- j) The Board shall have all powers for proper running of the institutions and for achieving the objects of the Trust to the fullest extent. They shall have powers to receive donations, contributions, in the form of money and any other assets in any shape or form and to hold the same as part of the capital fund or corpus of the Trust. However, any funds or gift or assets that is received shall be used only for advancing the objects of the Trust.
- k) To acquire on lease or by purchase or otherwise, to sell, mortgage, lease or transfer in any other manner whatsoever properties, movable or immovable, to construct buildings, and carry out other improvements thereof for the purpose of the Trust and to manage and deal with properties, movable or immovable and other assets of the Trust and to pledge them, to repay loans or otherwise, and to deal generally with the assets for the purpose of the Trust.
- l) To receive, collect or realise or cause collection or realisation of all interest, dividends, bonus or premium that accrues or become due on all or any stock, funds, securities, shares, debentures, deeds or documents of like nature.
- m) To sign and verify all pleadings, memorandum of appeal petition and application of all kinds, to compromise, abandon to refer to arbitration and whole or any part of the claim by or against the Trust, to engage lawyers and to take all such other necessary steps.
- n) Pay from the Trust funds, salaries, wages, rent and other expenses relating to the administration of the Trust, or relating to any activities or other affairs of the Trust.

9. Managing Trustee:- Smt. R.H. Usha, shall be the Managing Trustee for life. When the office of the Managing Trustee is vacated due to valid reasons acceptable by majority of Trustees, then the Board of Trustees shall appoint any one as the Managing Trustee for such a period they may deem fit.

10. Powers and duties of the Managing Trustee :

- a) The Managing Trustee shall convene the meeting of the Board of Trustees by serving notice of the meeting on the other members of the Board of Trustees in writing and setting out therein the matter to be discussed, the place of meeting, the day, date and time of meeting with atleast three days clear notice. However, the requirements of three days may be waived or the shorter notice may be ratified by a majority of the members of the Board.

b) The Managing Trustee shall be vested with all the powers to transact the business of the Trust in the interest of the TRUST and shall be accountable to the MANAGING COMMITTEE.

11. Operation of Funds : The funds of the TRUST shall be operated jointly by the Managing Trustee along with any one of the Trustees by opening an account or accounts in any Nationalised Banks, Schedule Banks or Co-operative Banks.

12. Borrowing : The Managing Trustee is empowered to raise loans or borrow funds from Banks and other financial institutions and to give properties of the Trust as securities for the betterment of the TRUST and for fulfilling its objectives.

13. Number of Trustees : The total strength of Managing Committee of Trustees at any time shall not be more than 9 (nine) and shall not be less than 3(three)

14. Meeting : The Managing Committee of the Trust shall ordinarily meet once in three months or at any time with prior notice to review the working of the Trust and to transact any other business of the Trust.

15. Audit of Accounts : The accounts of the Trust shall be got audited by a Chartered Accountant and financial statement so prepared shall be presented to the Managing Committee for its consideration at the Annual Meeting.

16. Annual General Meeting : The Annual General Meeting of the Trust shall be held after the close of the accounting year.

17. Ceasure of Trusteeship :

a) The Trusteeship of any Trustee shall cease on his/her resignation or death. In case of any misbehaviour or mischief by any Trustee he/she may be relieved from Trusteeship by a resolution passed by other Trustees and the vacancy shall be filled up by a new Trustee nomination by the Managing Committee.

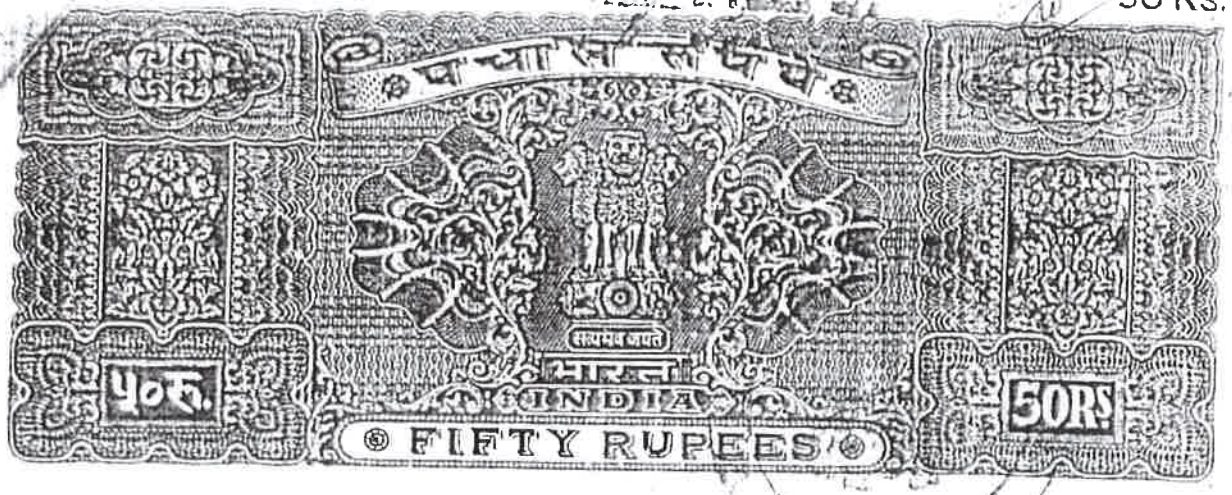
b) A Trustee may be removed, if he works against the objectives of the Trust provided atleast a majority of two thirds of the members of the committee as constituted from time give their consent to the removal of such member.

18. Quorum : The quorum for the meeting of the Managing Committee of the Trust shall be three.

19. Honourarium : The office of the members of the managing committee shall be honorary. However, honourarium could be paid to the Managing Trustee as may be decided by the Managing Committee.

20. Vacancy : Minimum number of three Trustees shall constitute Managing Committee of Trustees and when it is reduced to less than three then the remaining trustees shall have right to co-opt one or more member within a period of one month from the date of such reduction. In the event of not even one members existing, the power of appointing trustee shall vest with the court having jurisdiction over the place where the registered office of the Trust is situated.

21. Jurisdiction : The jurisdiction of the TRUST for achieving its objectives shall be the whole of Indian territory.

22. Application : The Trust shall be bound by the regulations of the Indian Trust act in all matters not specifically provided in this Trust Deed.

23. Investment Clause : The funds of the Trust shall be invested in the modes as specified under the provisions of section 13(1) (d) read with section 11(5) of the income tax act, 1961, as amended from time to time.

24. Amendment Clause :

i) The Board of Trustees shall have power from time to time to make and alter such rules and regulations with regard to the conduct of the business and all matters duly vested in them as they may deem fit.

ii) Nothing contained in this deed shall be deemed to authorise the Trustees to do any act which may in any way be constructed as violative or contrary to the provisions of section 2(15) 11, 12 and 13 and / or 80G of Income Tax Act, 1961 or any statutory modification thereof and all activities of the Trust shall be carried out with a view to benefit the public at large, without any profit motive and in accordance with the provisions of the income tax act 1961 or any statutory modifications thereof. Further no amendment shall be carried out without prior approval of the commissioner of income tax.

25. Dissolution : In the event of Dissolution or winding up of the TRUST, the assets remaining as on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed to the Trustees but shall be transferred to any other charitable trust whose objects are similar to those of this Trust.

- 1) The management shall impart education to the pupils from I Standard to IV Standard in Kannada medium or in mother tongue of the pupil as per the State Language Policy and they study Kannada as one of the languages from 5th Standard onwards.
- 2) The management shall get the recognition granted to it by the State Government even after the school gets affiliated to the CBSE every year, until it gets permanent recognition.
- 3) The Management shall subject itself to the over all control, Superintendence, Inspection of the State Education Department. The Management shall submit its annual audited statements of accounts of Income and Expenditure to Government every year along with application seeking renewal of recognition, and get approval on the same.
- 4) The State Education Department shall be competent to hold enquiry and take appropriate disciplinary action against the management in cases of complaints against the management.
- 5) The management shall not collect any donation from the students or their parents/guardians and collect only fees as prescribed by Government from time to time as per the provisions of the Karnataka Educational Institutions (Abolition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1984.
- 6) The management shall appoint only qualified staff conforming to the qualifications prescribed to the posts by the CBSE and get approval of the State Government in respect of each appointment made. There should be a written agreement between the management and each employee with regard to the nature of appointment, service conditions, pay and allowances, retirement benefits etc and copies of such agreement shall be available both the management and the employee concerned.
- 7) The management shall pay to its staff at a rate not lower than that paid by the Central Government to the corresponding central post.
- 8) No teacher/staff shall be removed from service without a proper enquiry as prescribed in respect of an employee of a State Aided Educational Institution and prior approval of the Deputy Director of Public Instruction concerned should be obtained before such removal.
- 9) Service conditions of employees under the management shall be fully protected as in the case of an employee of State Aided Educational Institution.
- 10) Children of employees of All India Service Central Government services liable to inter-state transfer/migrants from out of State who are temporarily put up in this State/Employees of All India Level Business/Commercial Industrial Establishments and Anglo-Indians shall get preference in admissions.
- 11) Ten percent of the admission in each class may be filled up at the discretion of the Education Department Authorities not below the rank of jurisdictional Deputy Director of Public Instruction. The Jurisdictional DDPI may issue directions in respect of such of the deserving students.
- 12) Any other condition that may be imposed in future.
